Academic Guidance

All successful applicants to the Research Assistance Program will be linked directly with an English speaking Egyptian University professor of repute. The professor will provide 30 hours of direct assistance to the researcher, including but not limited to the following categories:

Supervision of the research product from first formulations to finished text

Discussion on the research proposal and advice on amendments

Suggestion and arrangement of interviews with other Egyptian professors, experts, and personalities, where possible

Regular, structured meetings with researcher to discuss progress on paper

Thorough revision of the final draft, adding suggestions for improvement

Approval of final text, along with evaluation of the paper and researcher



Cooperating Professors

The ERA programme has crafted a cooperation agreement with Dr. Hassan Wagieh, head of the English Department at the Azhar University and Specialist of Intercultural Dialogue and Crisis Management.

Our network of Egyptian scholars is large and we should be able to find the professor with the specialty of your choice.



Qualifications and Structure of Program

Researchers must commit to assistance program for at least 3 consecutive months.

Room and board is not included in the base rate. However, ERA will work to provide you with the best available lodging options. In addition, many of our students receive grants to fund their expenses.

Is your thesis not related to Middle Eastern Studies? ERA also accepts students specializing in topics outside of the scope of the Arab West Report database, such as medicine, law, or economics. We can tailor our program specifically to meet your needs. A reduced rate is available for those studying such topics, since you will likely not need our assistance in procuring interviews, database access, or on-site consultancy.
